The Moravian Historical Society invites you to apply to be a food and beverage vendor at its Harvest Festival held on our historic site in Nazareth, Pennsylvania. The Festival will celebrate early American arts, culture and history by featuring artisans, music, entertainment, demonstrations, foods & libations!



Festival Guidelines:

- Please see the attached application and return **no later than Friday, October 8, 2021**
- All items for sale must follow state and local food safety guidelines.
- Each food vendor is responsible for their food area including furnishings and tents.
- All spaces are outdoors and 10 ft x 20 ft.
- **Notification:** As application is received
- **Electricity Charge:** \$30 (Due to a limited amount of electricity available.) Because power must be shared with other vendors and temporary power loss at such events is not uncommon, participants should be prepared for occasional power issues such as surges, outages, etc. Proper action should be taken by the vendor to protect any sensitive equipment with surge protectors, etc. No electrical cords or lights will be provided by the Moravian Historical Society.
- All booths are on a grassy surface – tents must be weighted or staked. Food trucks can park on our gravel driveway.
- Vendors are encouraged to bring hand carts to transport products to their booth during setup and breakdown. There is no on-site parking.
- An application is a commitment to show. There will be no refunds given after acceptance.
- Overnight camping is prohibited.
- No items may be attached to the buildings, trees or anything else on the property.
- MHS reserves the right to accept or decline any applications.
- Vendors cannot sublet, assign, donate, or trade spaces.
- No participant may solicit or distribute political or religious literature or materials.
- All participants are required to collect 6% PA sales tax and pay it to the state.
- A certificate of insurance with minimum coverage of \$500,000 for personal, business or other organizations. The following designation as “other insured” must be added to your insurance policy and submitted prior to participation in the festival: The Moravian Historical Society is named as additional insured with regards to Harvest Festival.
- We expect vendors to follow all current Covid-19 safety guidelines.
- Applications will not be processed without payment.
- **There will be no refunds.**
