The Moravian Historical Society invites you to apply to be a vendor at its Harvest Festival held on our historic site in Nazareth, Pennsylvania. The Festival will celebrate early American arts, culture, and history by featuring artisans, music, entertainment, demonstrations, foods & libations!

Festival Guidelines:

- **Application Deadline:** Friday, October 8, 2021
- **Space Fee:** 10' x 10' space: \$75; 10' x 20' space: \$100
- **Notification:** As application is received
- Participants may display and sell only their own original work. Commercially produced merchandise, imports and items assembled from commercially available plans, kits or molds are not eligible for exhibit or sale. Presence of such items will be grounds for closing of the booth space without fee refund.
- All participants must supply their own professional display and tent suitable for outdoor use.
- **Electricity Charge:** \$30 (Due to a limited amount of electricity available.) Because power must be shared with other vendors and temporary power loss at such events is not uncommon, participants should be prepared for occasional power issues such as surges, outages, etc. Proper action should be taken by the vendor to protect any sensitive equipment with surge protectors, etc. No electrical cords or lights will be provided by the Moravian Historical Society.
- All booths are on a grassy surface – tents must be weighted or staked.
- Vendors are encouraged to bring hand carts to transport products to their booth during setup and breakdown. There is no on-site parking
- An application is a commitment to show. There will be no refunds given after acceptance.
- No trailers or overnight camping are permitted.
- No items may be attached to the buildings, trees or anything else on the property.
- MHS reserves the right to accept or decline any applications.
- Vendors cannot sublet, assign, donate, or trade spaces.
- No participant may solicit or distribute political or religious literature or materials.
- All participants are required to collect 6% PA sales tax and pay it to the state.
- We expect vendors to follow all current Covid-19 safety guidelines.
- Please see the attached application and return **no later than Friday, October 8, 2021**
- Applications will not be processed without payment and three (3) photos of your art and one (1) of your display.
- **There will be no refunds.**
